Housing: We opened our first housing program for homeless veterans in 2003. Building on the esprit de corps found in the military, these programs provide wraparound services. Our programs enjoy a success rate of at least 80 percent. Most graduates leave with income and keys to their own place.

Employment: Volunteers of America is the top provider statewide in employment programs for veterans. As with our housing programs, these initiatives take advantage of the peer support found in the veteran community. Our professional case managers excel at preparing veterans for civilian work and providing the support to retain those jobs after placement.

Homeless prevention: Caseworkers serve very low-income veterans and their families. Services include case management, legal counseling and direct assistance with such barriers as back rent and security deposits, utility payments, child care.
